Our Parish Progress With the 2022 Annual Diocesan Stewardship Appeal

We have just completed week seven of the *Annual Diocesan Stewardship Appeal: To Know, Love and Serve*. As of this last week, 35.7% of participation for St. Joseph and 25% of participation for St. Ann for 2022. 41 of our St. Joseph families and 30 of our St. Ann families have participated in this year's appeal. We are grateful for everyone who has pledged or made a one-time gift thus far. Thank you.

Our goal is to improve our family participation over last year which was 29.2% for St. Joseph and 37.7% for St. Ann.
